

**2006 JavaOneSM Conference Hotel Registration Drawing
Official Rules**

No Purchase Required to Enter or Win.

1. **Eligibility:** The 2006 JavaOneSM Conference Hotel Registration Drawing (the “Promotion”) is open only to those who are 18 years of age or older as of the start of the Promotion Period (as defined below) and who are fully registered attendees of the 2006 JavaOneSM conference who have booked hotel accommodations through the online registration process as of the start of the Promotion Period. Void in Puerto Rico, Quebec and where prohibited by law. Employees of Sun Microsystems, Inc. and related companies and persons who are or were engaged in the development, production, distribution of materials, prizes, or drawing of the winner for this Promotion, including Conference Planners, as well as the immediate family (spouse, parents, siblings and children) and household members of each such persons, and government employees are not eligible. Subject to all federal, state and local laws and regulations.

3. **Agreement to Official Rules:** Participation in the Promotion constitutes entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules.

4. **Timing:**

In United States Pacific Time: The Promotion begins at 12:00:01 a.m. Pacific Standard Time on December 22nd, 2005 and ends at 11:59:59 p.m. Pacific Daylight Saving Time on April 28th, 2006 (the “Promotion Period”). Entries received prior to or after the Promotion Period will be disqualified.

In Central European Time: The Promotion Period begins at 9:00:01 a.m. on December 22nd, 2005 and ends at 8:59:59 a.m. on April 28th, 2006. Entries received prior to or after the Promotion Period will be disqualified.

5. **Entry:** There are two (2) ways to enter the Promotion:

Online Method: Visit <http://java.sun.com/javaone/sf> and book your hotel accommodation for the 2006 JavaOneSM conference through the 2006 JavaOneSM conference online registration process. In order to book your accommodation, follow the registration page instructions, including, but not limited to, entering your full name, title, company, mailing address, telephone number, facsimile number, email address, and JavaOneSM registration ID number in the spaces provided and clicking on “Submit.” Once you click on “Submit,” you will receive one (1) entry into the Promotion. Any use of robotic, repetitive, automatic, programmed or similar entry methods or agents (including, but not limited to, sweepstakes entry services) will void all entries by that entrant.

Mail-in Method: Send a self addressed post card to “2006 JavaOneSM Conference Registration Drawing,” c/o Conference Planners, 999 Skyway Road, Suite 300, San Carlos, CA 94070 USA, with your full name, title, company, mailing address, telephone number, facsimile number and email address. All mailed-in entries must be postmarked on or before April 28th, 2006 and received by Sponsor on or before May 1st, 2006.

For all Entries: Limit one (1) entry per person or email address, regardless of method of entry. Entries received by facsimile will be void. Proof of sending will not be deemed to be proof of receipt by Sponsor. All submitted entries are the sole property of Sponsor and will not be returned.

6. **Four (4) Prize:** Winners will receive a check for US\$250 payable to the individual chosen as the winner, as that name appears on the winning entry form. There will be four winners in total. Odds of winning depend on the number of completed entries received during the Entry Period. Winners will be announced on or around May 17th, 2006. The winners' names will be posted to <http://java.sun.com/javaone/sf>, included in the JavaOne conference daily newspaper, and winners will be notified by email. Prizes will be mailed to winners.

The winners are not permitted to substitute the prize or receive its cash equivalent. Sun reserves the right to substitute any or all of the prizes with any article or service of similar or greater value at its sole discretion. Prizes may not be assigned or transferred. Winner is solely responsible for any and all applicable fees and taxes associated with prize receipt and use, including any deposit, currency exchange/conversion or check cashing fees. All other expenses and costs not expressly listed above are solely the winner's responsibility. Participants are responsible for complying with their employers' policies regarding participation in sweepstakes and acceptance of prizes and/or related promotional items. Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received. All other expenses and costs not expressly listed above are solely the winner's responsibility. 8. **Requirements and Notification of Potential Winner:** The potential winners will be announced at the JavaOneSM conference and notified by email within 5 days of the drawing date. Potential winners do not have to be present at the announcement to win a prize. If potential winner cannot be contacted within 10 days after the first attempt to contact him/her, an alternate entrant will be selected in his/her place at random from all eligible entries received. Potential winner must comply with all terms and conditions of these Official Rules, and winning is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements. Except where prohibited, the potential winner must sign and return to Sponsor, within 10 days of being notified an affidavit of eligibility and liability/publicity release. If the potential winner fails to sign and return the affidavit of eligibility and liability/publicity release

within the required time period, or is deemed ineligible for any reason in Sponsor's sole discretion, an alternate entrant will be selected in his/her place at random from among all entries.

For Residents of Canada Only: Potential winner will be required to correctly answer a time-limited mathematical skill testing question (administered by telephone) without any assistance in order to receive a prize.

The winner's name may be published as required by law.
10. **Publicity:** Except where prohibited, participation in the Promotion constitutes winner's consent to Sponsor's use of winner's name, likeness, voice, opinions, biographical information and state/province and country of residence for promotional purposes in any media without further payment or consideration.
11. **General Conditions:** Sponsor reserves the right to cancel or modify the Promotion in its sole discretion or if any fraud, virus or other technical problem corrupts the administration, security, or proper administration of the Promotion, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. In such event, Sponsor reserves the right to award the prize at random from among the eligible entries received up to the time of the impairment. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Promotion or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to deliberately undermine the legitimate operation of the Promotion may be a violation of criminal and civil law, and, should such an attempt be made, Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. In the event there is a discrepancy between the English language version and another language version of these Official Rules or of any other Promotion materials, the English version shall prevail and govern. Sponsor's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision. In the event of a dispute as to any online entry, the authorized account holder of the e-mail address used to enter will be deemed to be the entrant. The "authorized account holder" is the natural person assigned an e-mail address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization responsible for assigning e-mail addresses for the domain associated with the submitted address. A potential winner may be required to show proof of being the authorized account holder.
12. **Release:** Except in Germany and the United Kingdom (only with respect to death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Sponsor) and where prohibited, by

Sponsor does not assume responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries. Sponsor is not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer on-line systems, servers or providers, computer equipment, software or failure of email on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website or combination thereof, including injury or damage to participants or to any other person’s computer related to or resulting from participating in the Promotion.
14. **Disputes:** Except where prohibited, entrant agrees that any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of, or connected with, the Promotion or any prize awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the appropriate court located in Santa Clara County, California, USA. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, entrant’s rights and obligations, or the rights and obligations of the Sponsors in connection with the Promotion, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of State of California, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules (whether of the State of California or any other jurisdiction), which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than State of California.
