**London Bridge JAIN Tech Day – A Smashing Success!** Over 75 people representing the Global JAIN Community crowded into the Sun London Bridge office to hear about the latest in JAIN Technology: JAIN SLEE, JAIN SIP, and future JAIN APIs. Because of the pace of JAIN Technology, the very obvious passion of the JAIN Community, and the audience overflow, another JAIN Technology Day is now scheduled for Munich on February 12<sup>th</sup> (details under 'Up-Coming Events'). European service providers such as British Telecom, France Telecom, Mobilkom Austria, Orange, Three, and Vodafone packed in to hear about the latest JAIN SIP and JAIN SLEE trials and deployments as well as API development on Instant Messaging, Presence, SIP for J2ME, and SIP Servlets.

Siemens shared their architecture of SIP Servlets within a 3G network, Nokia presented details of SIP for J2ME, Basevoice covered JAIN SIP, and Open Cloud, jNETx, and Vodafone dove deeply into JAIN SLEE. **Vodafone shares preliminary findings on JAIN SLEE**  
At the London Bridge JAIN Technology Day, Vodafone Spain shared information about their recently concluded trials of the JAIN SLEE products from Open Cloud and jNETx. The trials included testing for product functionality, performance, and reliability when used in a core network. The results from the trials disqualified several vendors with proprietary solutions and made JAIN SLEE a clear winner for the Vodafone network. Vodafone Global R&D also presented where and how the JAIN SLEE serves the IMS networks.
