ITU#1: Java.net Driving JAIN SIP APIs

At ITU World 2003, Java.Net made a press release around the success of JAIN SIP projects hosted at community.java.net/communications. Features on the community page include the details of JAIN SIP 1.1, the JAIN Certification process, and the newly released JSRs. Java.Net membership has climbed to over 23,000 in less than 120 days. Java.net is a web site used by the developer community to facilitate expansion of the Java technology portfolio of applications, tools and services in applied areas of technology and vertical industry solutions. Through collaborative tools such as weblogs and various open source tools, java.net allows developers to come to one place to find out the latest, and engage in efficient development efforts using Java technology. ITU#2: JAIN SLEE partner demos and solutions

Open Cloud demonstrated their Open Java Standard Service Environment for mass market services in the core network. jNETx demonstrated its Open Convergent Feature Server.

Every delegate stopped by the booth and asked, "What is JAIN SIP?", or "What is JAIN SLEE?". Interest and acceptance of JAIN Technology is on the rise as JAIN Implementations are maturing. Network was over 8,000. JAIN Partners exhibiting included jNETx.

JAIN Technology Days – newer, smaller , better,...Remember the old JAIN Community 4 day meetings at some exotic locale (e.g., Piscataway, NJ)? Because of the current economic climate – which is, no company has budget to travel, large 4 day JAIN Community meetings have been retooled to 1 day JAIN Technology seminars. Expert Groups, Focus groups, and Vendor Show cases are add-ons to these one day venues.

The JAIN Technology Days also reflect a transition from defining specifications to vendor Implementations. Expert group meetings are held, but there is a lot more show'n'tell going on with vendors demonstrating their JAIN implementations and users exchanging ideas on solutions.

At the JAIN Technology Day in McLean, VA, over 50 participants from companies such as Nextel, Verizon, NTT, and Cingular, came to hear tutorials on JAIN SIP, JAIN SLEE, and emerging JSRs such as JAIN IMP, and JAIN PAM. Cool demonstrations were performed by Sun utilizing JAIN SIP1.1 on a IM client to invoke conference calling. An Operators Focus Team meeting was held the next day with key JSLEE companies proposing new ideas.
